EMERGENCY PLAN: EVACUATION

- 1 Explain **modus operandi** to class (see information sheet)
- Indicate <u>"Head"</u>. He/she leads the class group to the **nearest exit** as quickly and orderly as possible. Consult information sheet on evacuation.
- Indicate <u>"Tail"</u>. He/she moves to the door to count pupils (after the signal for evacuation has been given!) As the class group moves out, he/she remains at the back and at the relevant **safety point** (see map) the 'tail' helps the relevant teacher to check whether all the learners (in class group) are there.
- 4 "Head" leads class group to safety point as indicated on map.
- 5 "Tail" therefore tells you at security point if everyone is present!
- 6 Learners line up and remain dead silent. "**Head**" in front and "**Tail**" at the back.
- After the teacher and "tail" have checked learner numbers (class group), "head" or "tail" is sent to report to person in charge of that relevant area (called **area manager**).
- 8 "Area managers" information by messenger to control point 7. (see map).

EMERGENCY PLAN: Evacuation of school

1 **GENERAL PURPOSE**

To evacuate the school building as quickly and as decently as possible in an emergency or simulated emergency.

2 WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS IN PREMISES

In each room there is a school plan on which the various exits and shortest routes to them are indicated.

3 INDICATIONS

- 3.1 In each class group that occupies a room at any stage, a "head" and a "tail" are designated by that relevant teacher.
- 3.2 The function of the "tail" is to move immediately to the door and count the pupils as they leave the class, stay at the back of the line and at the security point help the teacher in question check whether all the pupils arrived and if they are "safe".
- 3.3 The "head's" function is to lead the class group as quickly and orderly as possible to the nearest exit, according to the prescribed method. He/she will have to be able to show judgment in case there are obstacles in his/her way. If he/she notices something, he/she must report it to the teacher later at the security point. The "head" and "tail" should always have visual contact during the procession. Hand gestures help.
- 4 **PROCEDURE**: During interruptions in electrical and communication connections
- 4.1 The signal for evacuation is given from the Van Jaarsveld portal. If the siren cannot be used, a car's horn will be pressed repeatedly.
- 4.2 As soon as this signal for evacuation is heard, the teacher, "head" or "tail" gives the following command:
 - We are now going to evacuate the school building. Stay calm and decent. (Students with special tasks leave the room.)
 - Open your book bag check if there is anything that looks suspicious you should know.
 - Open your desk check if there is anything that appears suspicious and leave the desks's lid open, if possible.
 - Suspicious articles are not touched, but are reported to the teacher, "head" or "tail"
 - Each pupil takes his "safe" bag and follows the 'head'. No time is wasted.
 - Teacher turns off the lights, closes the door and follows his/her pupils.

- 4.3 No one runs, keep quiet, walk briskly and keep your eyes open.
- 4.4 The "head" leads their class group to the relevant safety point as indicated on the map.
- 4.5 Pupils line up at the safety points (see attached site plan). "Head" at the very front and "tail" at the back.
- 4.6 The teacher and the "tail" now check whether all the pupils who were in the relevant room are at the security point and then send the "head" or "tail" to report to the person in charge of that relevant area.
